

3. Travelling by Train – Irish Rail

Iarnród Éireann operates rail services from Dublin Heuston Station to Galway Ceannt Station.

Step-by-Step

From Dublin Airport

1. Travel from Dublin Airport to Heuston Station by taxi or coach. ([Taxi Services at Dublin Airport | Pick-Up, Drop-Off & Fare Info](#)) (782 Bus)
2. Board train from Dublin Heuston to Galway.
3. Journey time is approximately:
 - 2 hours 20 minutes to 2 hours 50 minutes

Wheelchair and Mobility Supports on Irish Rail

Irish Rail provides:

- wheelchair spaces
- boarding ramps
- staff assistance
- accessible toilets on many services
- priority seating

Wheelchair spaces are limited and should be booked in advance.

Deaf and Hard of Hearing Supports on Irish Rail

Supports may include:

- visual display screens
- visual station announcements
- onboard information screens
- staff assistance

If you need communication support, notify staff when booking assistance.

Blind or Vision Impaired Supports on Irish Rail

Irish Rail can provide:

- staff assistance through stations
- boarding support
- help locating platforms
- support during transfers

Guide dogs and assistance dogs are permitted.

Autism and Sensory Supports on Irish Rail
